

Eisenhower Volleyball Booster Meeting

Present: Coach Ackerman, Angie Brown, Cindi Fitterer, Heather Hein, Jo Johnston, Donna & Bob Nevins, Kathy Ortiz, Carrie Skahan

Donna Nevins Ike Volleyball Boosters President, called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

Minutes: Minutes from February 1, 2010 meeting was reviewed and a motion was made to approve with no changes, seconded and unanimously approved.

Treasurer's Report: A brief summary of the account was presented. Angie noted that \$1,000 was transferred from savings to pay for the Gold Medal deposit, the balance of which will be due in May. Tori Fisher has been selected for the Allstate Team and has requested a \$100 sponsorship. As this was a non-budgeted item, A MOTION was made to provide sponsorship, SECONDED and unanimously APPROVED.

Angie B. has begun the process of reviewing the Booster's 1099 non-profit status for tax purposes.

The 2010 budget should be considered at the next board meeting. NOTE: Need to add to the 2010 budget fees for website. This had been alternated with Spikers in previous years and was dropped from the budget making process. Discussion ensued on the domain fees, the need for separate domains, bandwidth and amount of space needed for pictures, etc. Angie B. will contact Lisa Gredvig, webmaster for both the ikevball.com and yakimaspikers.com to discuss options.

Added after the meeting, an email vote of Booster officers the following: MOTION – Continue to share cost/domain with Yakima Spikers and Ike VB, with fees to be alternated every other year between the two booster clubs. Odd years, Yakima Spikers – Even years, Ike VB. Unanimously APPROVED. Fee - \$119.40 due by March bi-annually.

OLD BUSINESS:

AAU Best in the West Basketball Fundraiser – Washington Middle School 5/7-9 Girls & 5/14-16 Boys – Chair

Donna Nevins – Donna N. has completed all forms with the school district and AAU to manage the AAU basketball event on the two weekends in May. A request was made for Day Captains (2), and an email will be sent out to all for volunteers. Donna N. will coordinate the food for sales. A roster of athlete (and parent) volunteers for timers/concessions/gate is needed but, at the request of Coach Ackerman, athletes with their deposit made for Gold Medal camp will have priority. Monies earned will go toward Gold Medal camp. Angie B. will get the list of those athletes that have mailed in their deposit. OPEN

– Coach Ackerman will order the "Attach Pak" for the camp – pak to include shirt, small volleyball, water bottle and picture. He will also coordinate with Russ Dix to take the camp pictures. Angie B. will obtain the flyers from Russ D. for Internet posting, mailing to Spikers players, previous year's participants and distribution to middle school coaches. The flyers are to be out NLT 3/15/10. Deposit for Gold Medal is 4/15/10. It was agreed that the following is to be added to the flyers: **All fees are non-refundable.** Coach Ackerman will ask the Dixes if they would consider providing lodging for the visiting coaches again.
